
A Brief Word from the Pastor Matt Franks

- 1) On Your Phone Dial: +1 346 248 7799 US
- 2) You will be prompted to enter the meeting ID the nine (9), ten (10), or eleven (11) digit ID provided to you by the leader, followed by (#) button. a) If you want a meeting id call the church office and we can provide you the meeting id and Passcode number. We do not post these to limit the chances of the meeting being hacked.
- 3) You will then be asked to put in your participant id. Use your Phone Number then hit (#) button.
- 4) Last, you will put in the Passcode Number provided by the leader. Then hit (#) button. In the meeting If you are asked to mute or unmute just hit (*) (6) on your phone Toggle mute/unmute. To end the call just hang up.
